Does it Hurt?

There is a little sting to it. Some compare it to being snapped with a rubber band. GatSplat Facilities use exclusively low impact, 50 caliber paintball guns. Our hits will have 1/3 the sting of a conventional paintball gun. That is why kids as young as 6 can play at GatSplat Fields. Yes, paintballs really don't have paint in them. It's a food grade filler, actually used in toothpaste, that washes out easily.
